Paediatric Intensive Care Society Trainee's Audit and Research Collaborative Network

PICSTAR is a collaborative network for Paediatric Intensive Care Society (PICS) trainees and other interested parties (eg. Paediatric Intensive Care Medicine (PICM) Advanced Nurse Practitioners and PICM clinical fellows). PICSTAR was founded by two PICM grid trainees to enable trainees to become involved in multi-centre, national audit and research projects.

How does it work?

PICSTAR will hold a secure database of it's members and representatives from Paediatric Intensive Care Units (PICU) and Paediatric Intensive Care Transport Services across the UK. There will be one local representative from each PICU/Transport service who will co-ordinate projects locally (within their PICU). PICSTAR projects (audits, surveys or small research projects) will be advertised to local representatives and who will then co-ordinate local data collection with local PICSTAR members. Results will be published nationally bearing the PICSTAR name and logo with all contributors being individually named. All material proposed for publication resulting from collaborative network efforts would be reviewed prior to publication to assure quality.

PICSTAR is supported by PICS, PICS-SG and RCPCH PICM ISAC.
