PCCS framework for informing decisions around promoting international conferences

- A) The following events will be <u>actively</u> promoted by PCCS (e.g. conference details circulated to members via group email and other communications platforms eg twitter), the following criteria must be satisfied:
 - 1. Content is of relevance to PCCS (as decided by Hon Sec/ Communication officer/ President; decision by consensus)
 - 2. Attendance at the event does not REQUIRE air travel i.e. the event is overseas but it is expected that international speakers/delegates <u>will</u> attend the event virtually

Other criteria to be considered:

- 3. The event organisers have published a sustainability / climate change statement.
- 4. The event has a diverse range of speakers, in terms of gender and ethnicity (as guided by PCCS EDI policy)
- B) The following events may be promoted in a limited fashion by PCCS (conference details on PCCS website, but no wider circulation of information to members)
 - 1. Content is <u>highly relevant</u> to PCCS (as decided by Hon Sec/ Communication officer/ President; decision by consensus).
 - 2. Attendance at the event REQUIRES air travel i.e. the event is overseas but there is a hybrid option that allows international* speakers/delegates to attend virtually
 - 3. The event organisers have published a sustainability / climate change statement with clarity around position/ intentions on air travel

Other criteria to be considered:

- 4. The event has a diverse range of speakers, in terms of gender and ethnicity (as guided by PCCS EDI policy)
- C) The following events will <u>not</u> be promoted by PCCS
 - 1. Content is of no relevance to PCCS (as decided by Hon Sec/ Communication officer/ President; decision by consensus)
 - 2. Attendance at the event REQUIRES air travel i.e. the event is overseas and there is no option but for international speakers/ delegates to attend in person
